

Seventh Annual Eagle Survey of the Pipestem area Saturday, January 7, 2012

On Saturday January 7, 2012 there were 38 people who participated in the Seventh Annual eagle count along the New, Bluestone, and Greenbrier Rivers.

Participants counted from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM. With people positioned at: Bluestone State Park, Mouth of Bluestone River, Rt. 20, Bellepoint park in Hinton, Bull Falls, Bertha campground (Bluestone WMA), Greenbrier River (from Talcott to Hinton), Brooks Island, Sandstone Falls,

We totaled 19 bald eagles, (7 adult, 5 first year, 3 second year, 2 third year, and 2 fourth year) and 1 adult golden eagle.
